#### Terms & Conditions

1. Information on how to enter and Prize form part of these conditions of entry. Entry in the promotion is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry.
2. The Promoter is Hachette Australia, Level 17, 207 Kent St, Sydney, NSW, 2000.
3. The promotion ("Competition Period") commences on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2011 at 00:01am (AEST) and closes at 5.00pm (AEST) Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> February 2012. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries.
4. Entry is open to Australian residents only.
5. If the Prize Winner is under the age of 18 years, the Prize will be awarded to the winner's nominated parent or guardian.
6. Hachette Australia and Expedia staff, associated companies, customers and their immediate families are not permitted to enter this competition.
