
Before I was an author I was ... a technical writer, and before that, an engineer. I'm still both on occasion (and a fairly serious nerd). It's useful having all these past lives!







I started writing because ... I loved reading and wanted to create my own stories. I wrote my first book aged five and it was about flying sharks attacking battleships. It was pretty awesome and I feel quite certain the producers of Sharknado found it somewhere and ripped it off. Legal action is pending.

The best part of writing *Australia's Sweetheart* was ... the sense of discovery involved in researching someone who's forgotten and finding that, despite the passage of a century, there are still thousands of records out there. Even better – and more amazing – was finding people who knew her. The moment one of Mary's ninety-year-old relatives in Long Beach, California, brought out a stack of photo albums was spine-tingling.

***Australia's Sweetheart* was inspired by ...** a chance discovery while researching a historical novel about an Australian teenage girl who goes to Hollywood in 1936. In a 1936 newspaper I found an article about an Australian teenage girl going to Hollywood. Even after a career writing about film, I'd never heard of Mary Maguire – and so the novel gradually receded into the background because fact proved stranger than fiction.
